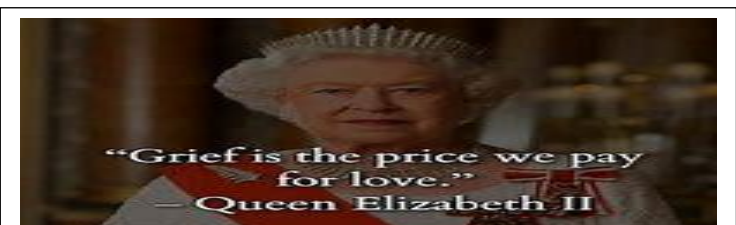
Next Monthly Lunch at St. Aidan's will be on **Sunday 25th September.** The sign-up sheet will be in the narthex.
