Sister Jacinta Davenport thanks the parish for the donation **£540.20** received to support their mission in Albania.

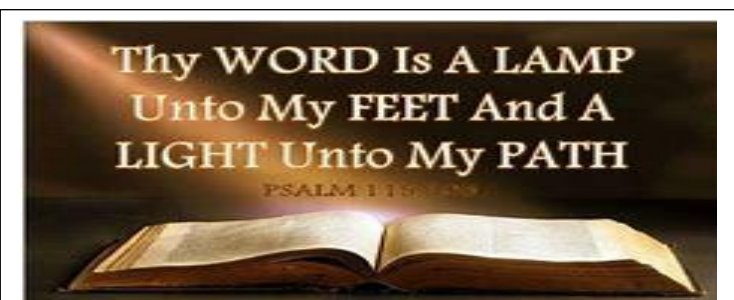
Food Bank: Please continue with our donations as previously, namely: tinned meat, tinned tuna, sponge puddings, rice puddings, custard and UHT milk.
